This is the extension of two rather remarkable conferences organised in 1996, one in Lady Margaret Hall, Oxford, the other at King's College, London, one outcome of which was F.G. Jacobs and M. Andenas Community Law in the English Courts (Oxford). This conference takes the project one step further: it is not primarily the *application* of Community law but the *development* of Community law by English courts which is the topic this time. The European Court's own jurisprudence on Article 234 EC references from national courts, many important English cases and the proposals before the Nice Intergovernmental Conference and the broader constitutional discussion to give national courts a more important role in developing Community law, all make the conference subject highly topical and important.
